# Additional Safe Management Measures (SMMs)

- No singing or loud cheering will be allowed
- Temperature checks throughout the day
- Hand-washing will be done frequently
- Mask-wearing will be mandatory for all activities except during mealtimes
- Safe-distancing will be implemented and observed at all times
- Classes will be allocated designated toilets
- Disinfection of venues will be done after each activity
- Wipe-down of equipment will also be conducted after each activity
